



Let's Build with Wood Enrichment Class

Explore the world of wood working in this hands-on, creative, construction class! From playful to practical, kids learn basic wood working skills while creating their own projects each week. No artistic experience is necessary. All wood and recycled materials and supplies are included.

Week- 1. Porcupine Pets- Kids practice using hammers to nail on their porcupine's quills.
Materials: Wood Wedges, Nails, Hammers, Markers

Week- 2. Candle Holders- This project lets students build a candle holder to showcase at the dinner table and use.
Materials: Wood Blocks, Measuring Tapes, Pencils, Drill, Hammers, Nails, Screws, Screwdrivers

Week- 3. Hanging Wooden Signs- This project is a fun and easy project kids will make to display. They will measure, drill and sand pre-cut boards to paint.
Materials: Wood Boards, Wire, Drill, Measuring Tapes, Pencils, Wire, String, Sand Paper, Craft Paint

Week- 4. Life Size Catapults- Kids build simple wood catapults with just two pieces of wood, nails and hammers.
Materials: 1" x 4" Wood Boards, Small Blocks, Measuring Tapes, Nails, Hammers

Week- 5. Making Faces- Using wood blocks and scrap pieces kids create faces to match any mood they choose.
Materials: 1" x 4" Wood Boards, Small Blocks, Measuring Tapes, Nails, Hammers, Masking Tape and Craft Paint

Week- 6. Chunky Block Characters- This project has kids assembling wood pieces and found objects of various sizes to make a block character.
Materials: Various Small Wood Pieces, Small Recycled Items, Nails, Hammers, Wood Glue, Measuring Tapes, Pencils

Week- 7. Spinning Tops- This week kids will make mini spinning tops then color them to make them swirl color as they spin.
Materials: Various Small Wood Pieces, Nails, Hammers, Wood Glue, Measuring Tapes, Pencils, Craft Paint
